

Motorcycle Rights For Future



As almost everyone knows, Tahnissa has resigned from the Legislative position, and the LLA BOD has assigned me as the temporary Legislative person. I am honored to take the position. I can not stress this fact; thank you. However, I will only be in this position until someone can take it. I do not need to labor you with a list of reasons. The one I will mention is the fact I live in Logan County. When talking to representatives, the Lincoln Land Chapter members would be better served by someone living in Sangamon County in its districts. If anyone is interested, please let the board or myself know. You can shadow me, and I'll tell you how easy it can be.

Now, the actual legislative issues. Ski came across at Love's gas station in Hamel, IL. 87 and 89 were 15% ethanol, with the 91 option being 10% Ethanol, all on the same pump. Meaning if you used 91, you would get a few gallons of the precious gas. There is no label saying anything about how motorcycles can not use gas that is over 10% ethanol. The pump did have a label saying what year of vehicle can use it. However, this only refers to passenger vehicles, which motorcycles aren't classified as. Ski and Hunter John are looking into it. Ski also believes the Love's at Williamsville might do the same. If you want more information, come to talk to me.

Ski has been doing one hell of a job already in this early stage of the 2024 session. Here are some things he has been doing in the capital from day 1 of the session. Caulkins will file an anti-AV bill, and Benton will likely sponsor the anti-sound camera bill. If not him, then Marty. He discussed the Ohio bill preserving the Internal Combustion engine with Severin. Ski sent him language, and he will get something drafted and filed; discussed strategy with Spain & Windhorst on protecting incumbents with bills. The 2024 Primary Voter's Guide is available in the back of your State ABATE Newsletter. Take a look and see how your representatives and candidates are graded. Some people aren't graded because they didn't send back an ABATE survey or insufficient information on them. The Illinois Primary is March 19; get out there and vote!







A written essay of 1500 to 2500 words covering the listed topic ideas concerning issues supported by ABATE of Illinois.


Topic Ideas:
