

Legislative Report George Tinkham

Lincoln Land Chapter made a strong showing at this year's Legislative Day held by A.B.A.T.E. of Illinois on Wednesday, April 17th. It seemed that we had as many members taking time out of their day to lobby their representatives as we usually have at our meetings. Although most of our representatives and senators were busy in committees, we met with their staffs and left a position paper outlining our concerns. Those concerns include:

HB5620, a mandatory helmet bill sponsored by Representative Daniel Didech (D). Representative Margaret Croke (D) has signed on as a co-sponsor. Until she did that, she was endorsed by A.B.A.T.E. PAC. She has now been un-endorsed! This bill has been in Rules Committee since 4/5/24.

HB1634 would require Illinois to enforce California Air Resources Board (C.A.R.B.) regulations. This bill has been in Rules Committee since 4/5/24.

HB1108 would require Chicago to have a noise monitoring system on Outer Park Drive. This has been in Rules Committee since 3/10/24.

A.B.A.T.E. supports two bills that limit autonomous vehicles (HB2053 & HB4483). We oppose HB2913 would allow these vehicles on the street with no oversight by the government.

We are working to make more cycle safety training facilities available. I have volunteered to draft legislation that protects property owners who do not conduct training, but merely allows training to occur on their land, from unwarranted claims.

SB1556 is basically a fuel formulization bill with the goal of electrification of transportation and decarbonizing liquid fuels. This is sponsored by Senator David Koehler (D) from East Peoria. There is a committee deadline of May 3rd. A.B.A.T.E. has not expressed a position on this bill, to the best of my information.

Thank you for welcoming me back as temporary chapter Legislative Coordinator. I am glad to be of service, but – all things considered – I would rather be riding!

- 1. Never assume that drivers can or do see you.
- 2. Use extra caution when riding through construction areas.
- 3. Avoid riding in poor weather conditions.
- 4. Position yourself out of a driver's blind spots.
- 5. When riding always wear reflective clothing.

For MOTORISTS:

- 6. Reduce your speed and increase stopping distance.
- 7. Exercise extra caution while at intersections.
- 8. Check your blind spots before making any lane changes.
- 9. Have passengers alert you of a motorcycle rider's presence.


